

# Super League / DSL

Development Soccer League

The **SUPER LEAGUE** / **DSL LEAGUE MANAGEMENT** Committee have discussed and ratified the following at a meeting held on Friday April 29<sup>th</sup> 2018. With **IMMEDIATE EFFECT** the following will take place:

1. A player born in the month of October, November and December can play in the lower age group: ***EG. turning 13 in the above mentioned months, the athlete can play for the under 12 team***
2. Substitutions in Under 15 age group to be changed from 5 SUBS on and off to **ROLLING SUBS.**
3. No more League changes to occur. Should any changes be done these must be done on the Monday prior to weekend games and not later in the week.
4. The leagues will be reviewed for teams to be moved down or up based on scores on the 14 May 2018 week prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> Cup Round to be played. Super / DSL League 1<sup>st</sup> Round of Cup scheduled for SUNDAY MAY 20<sup>th</sup> 2018
5. Games not played due to late changes made to schedules and clubs did not see the changes; teams may reschedule these games.
6. Clubs to advise there LFA so that dates can be agreed for all concerned.
7. All League matches must be completed before the IDT tournament scheduled for Friday September 28<sup>th</sup> 2018 – Sunday September 30<sup>th</sup> 2018.
8. The IDT Tournament will be hosted by Southern LFA.
9. Field markings – Small Sided Games: Clubs **may** use cones, tape to demarcate some of the lines where it's not possible to be marked due to restrictions in place. Clubs must be reasonable about this matter and use common sense
10. Night games scheduled to be played at 7:30pm kick off can be moved to an earlier time as agreed by the two clubs so that players can get home earlier where problems of transport occurs . This change **MUST** be advised to respective LFAS and [jimmy@rclfa.co.za](mailto:jimmy@rclfa.co.za)

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11. The minimum number of players in SSG for a League match to be played where teams are short of a full team are as follows :

AGE GROUP	FORMAT	MINIMUM PLAYERS
UNDER 06	4v4 (RCLFA) or 5v5 (ELFA)	3 players
UNDER 07	4v4 (RCLFA) or 5v5 (ELFA)	3 players
UNDER 08	7v7	5 players
UNDER 09	7v7	5 players
UNDER 10	9v9	6 players
UNDER 11	9v9	6 players
UNDER 12	9v9	6 players
UNDER and Older	11v11	7 players

12. Correspondence on a WhatsApp or SMS does not apply where Team or Club representatives communicate to agree or confirm changes. ALL correspondence must be in writing on an email, fax or letter to the Administrators. Clubs must fill in the Re Scheduled form when changing a scheduled game. Form must be filled in and signed by both clubs.
13. Clubs affiliated to the LFAs will be receiving **SL / DSL** correspondence directly from the League convenor and the LFAs will also receive copies of such correspondence.
14. **ALL TEAMS** will supply the match official a completed filled out Team Returns **BEFORE** the start of a scheduled match. Team returns will contain the following information:
- Player Card Number
  - Player Name
  - Player Jersey number
  - The match officials will be advised to call the match off if teams returns are **NOT** ready before the match. **NO GRACE PERIOD**. Scheduled matches **WILL** start on time as per the schedules. The only change to this rule is for the **DSL / SL** scheduled Cup matches (see Cup rules)
15. **SL / DSL** League results must please be submitted to [dslslresults@gmail.com](mailto:dslslresults@gmail.com) **ONLY** and on the RESULT TEMPLATE supplied. Results submitted to any other mail and not on the template **WILL NOT BE RECORDED**.
